## 2. Partner Updates & News:

- **a. Community Farmer's Market at Chehalis:** Chelle Bonham informed the group of a spring event at the Olympic Club in Centralia, more information to follow.
- **b.** Lewis County Historical Museum: Jason Matteson informed the group that a World War I exhibit is now on display at the museum. He also informed the group of an upcoming event regarding local mythology which will take place on March 28<sup>th</sup>.
- c. Young Professionals of Lewis County: Trevor Elliott spoke of mentorship program with the school district. Randy Mueller spoke about internship programs within the community and encouraged everyone to participate, emphasizing the need to inspire youth to stay in the area.
- **d.** Executive Director Report: Annalee Tobey told the group about the recent ribbon cutting at Spry and her excitement to work with them. The benefits of the newly installed fiber internet were discussed.
