Brandon Rakes - Chehalis-Centralia Airport

The train's operations are currently on hold because their insurance company did not renew their policy. The organization is currently seeking insurance for onsite activities and is working with a team to have the insurance reinstated later this year. Repair of the rail line due to January's flood damage is underway with possible support from FEMA.

Laura Six - Economic Vitality Committee

- Annalee and Laura are attending monthly seminars hosted by Rural Development Initiative with other main street communities focused on economic vitality programs. It will be a year-long commitment.
