## **Twin Transit**

- New transit station has been opened
- Expanded route to Olympia
- Dial-a-ride available Winlock to Olympia. Inexpensive option and funded through state grant subsidizing 500 rides a month
- Hydrogen is more expensive than electric at this point
- Diversifying fuel sources. Some airlines are doing testing of new fuel sources. Our location could play a key role with future development.

## **Economic Alliance of Lewis County - Eric Sonnenberg**

- Name change last year from Lewis County Economic Development Council has been well received.
  The new name sends a message of cooperation.
- · Recruitment to the area is in full swing
  - o Ryerson Steel in Centralia hopes to be open by July bringing 85-90 jobs to the area.
  - Working on wage scale
  - Georgia Pacific in Centralia
- First golf tournament last year was a great success. Planned this year.
- The Alliance's Business Development Center has helped 13-15 businesses to date
- Alliance membership is a priority. Three year ago there were 50 members, now 160 members
- · Both local ports are very busy with a lot of interest from new companies right now
- First Mode Hydrogen out of Seattle is interested in testing their trucks here
- Other hydrogen-focused projects are in the works

## Chehalis-Centralia Railroad & Museum - Joanne Schwartz

- · Working on getting liability insurance and passenger insurance
- CCRM has added Bill Deutscher as a new volunteer risk manager
- Looking at their current structure and enlisting the help of Tobey Altborst leading a new citizens group to evaluate the structure.
- Pursuing FEMA funding to fix damage caused by flood.
