Joanne Schwartz - Chehalis-Centralia Railroad & Museum

- Currently not able to run the train.
- They are hosting an escape room and dinner train on the train while stationary. The series is called "One the Train...At the Depot."
- They will be having a magic-themed train, Wizard Express with magician Jeff Evans.
- They are looking for resources to help in their recovery after the flood. Track repairs are currently underway. The repairs from the flooding that occurred in January will cost approximately \$500,000.
- Volunteers are taking this opportunity to do training.
- They had great media coverage on King 5 last week.

Lindsey Senter - Port of Chehalis

- There are currently 2 purchase and sale agreements in process at 0 Rush Road and 273
 Maurin Rd. 0 Rush Rd would be sold to a developer for \$9.3 Million and would close at
 the end of 2023 at the latest.
- Development:
 - Dawson Rd. The Port is pursuing a design grant for property on the corner of Jackson Hwy. and Maurin Rd. to potentially devleop more bay user space for light industrial business.
 - The Hydrogen Facility project with Twin Transit and Economic Alliance would add a Hydrogen Fueling station and a business park.
 - SW Grain Facility
 - Partnership with Economic Alliance, Northwest Business & Agricultural Center.
 - Working to submit a \$3 million EDA Grant to fund Phase 1 to build grain silos and conveyance for local farmers. Phase 2 would add buildings to host value-added agriculture users to support local agriculture.
 - Berwick Creek Habitat and Restoration Project is currently having design work performed to improve habitat on the creek that runs under Rush Road.

- The Port acts as the administrator for LCFCD#1 and is working with the Chehalis River Basin Flood Authority to support a regional approach to flood mitigation
- The Port is currently at capacity and is looking at adding leasable space.

- There are many projects currently underway or recently finished that were funded by facade grants.
