## **Now Open: Washington Hospitality Grants**

This program will award one-time grants to eligible restaurants, hotels, motels, and other small hospitality businesses in Washington State that were negatively impacted by the COVID-19 public health crisis.

## Eligible hospitality businesses include:

- Restaurants
- Food stands, food trucks, food carts
- Caterers
- · Bars, saloons, lounges, taverns
- Snack and nonalcoholic beverage bars
- · Bakeries\*
- Brewpubs, tasting rooms, taprooms\*

- Breweries or microbreweries\*
- Wineries and distilleries\*
- Licensed facilities or premises of a beverage alcohol producer where the public may taste, sample, or purchase products
- Inns, bed and breakfast (onsite sales of food and beverage to the public comprise at least 25% of gross receipts or sales, or at least 5 private lodging rooms)
- Hotels and motels (except casino hotels)
- Bowling Alleys (Based on funding availability)
- Convention and Visitors Bureaus (Based on funding availability)

\*onsite sales to the public comprise at least 25% of gross receipts or sales

A portion of the available funding will be set aside specifically to reimburse *lodging establishments* that experienced losses during the state's eviction moratorium pursuant to the governor's proclamations.

"Lodging establishment" refers to a hotel, motel, or similar establishment taxable by the state under chapter 82.08 RCW that has 40 or more lodging units.

## Actual eligible losses include:

- · Room charges not paid by persons who stayed during the moratorium,
- Any legal expenses incurred by lodging establishments as a result of the moratorium,
- and any repair expenses directly attributed to damages to rooms.
