



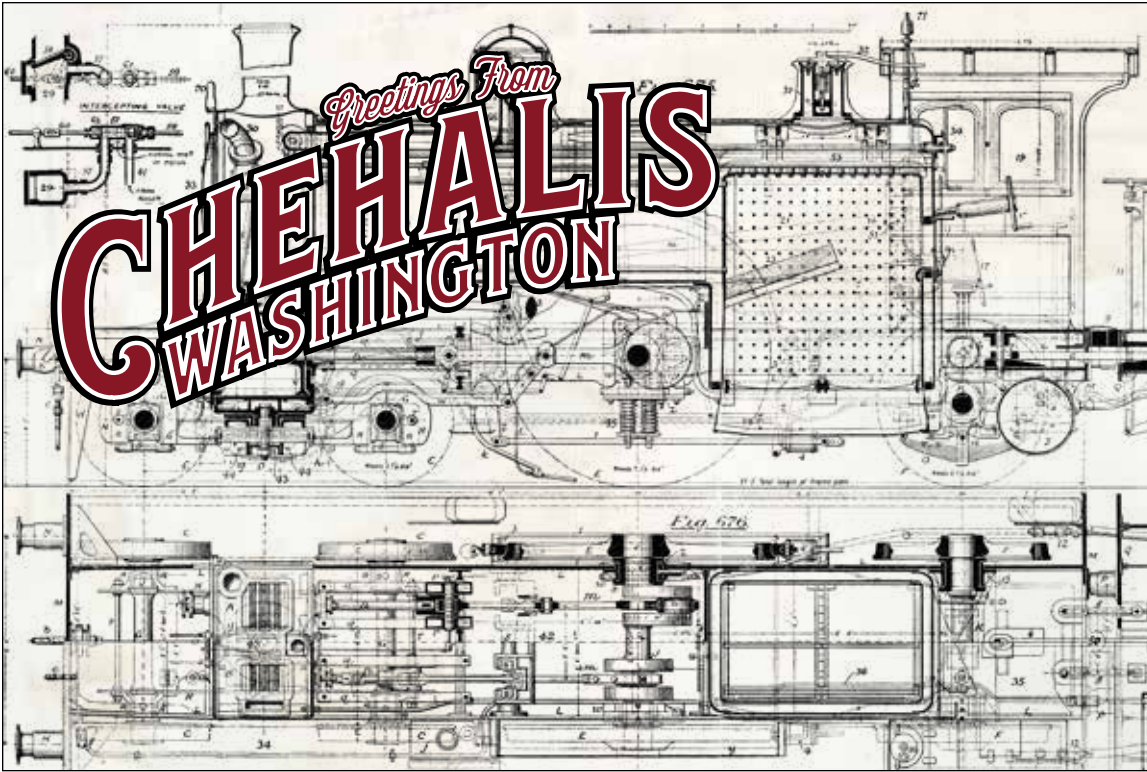

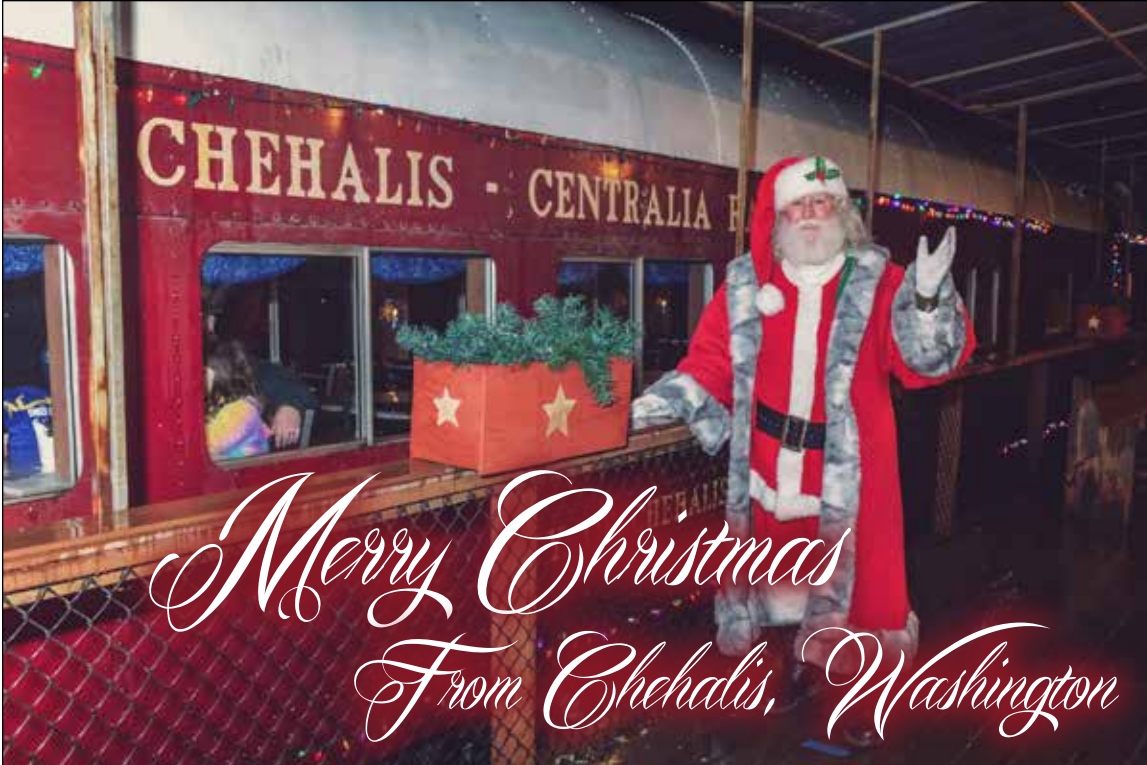
Description on back:

The Carnegie-inspired Vernetta Smith Chehalis Timberland Library opened in 2008 largely funded by private investment. It features Washington's first drive-through library window.

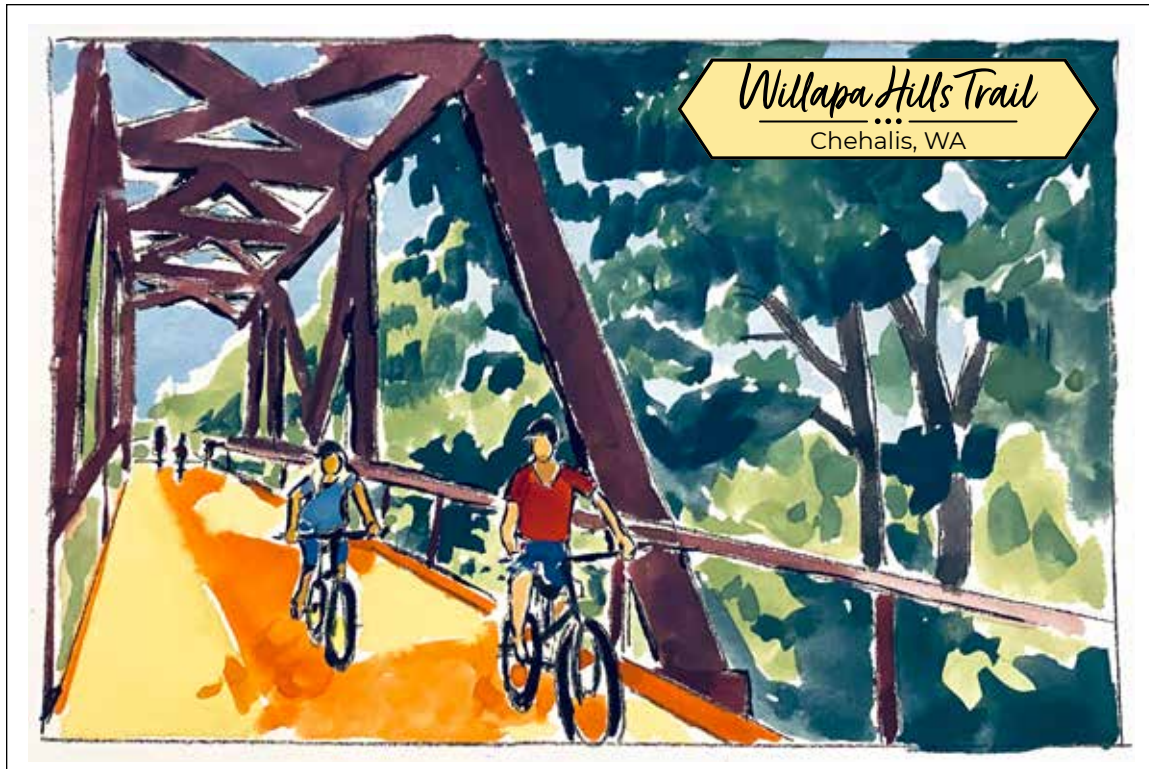

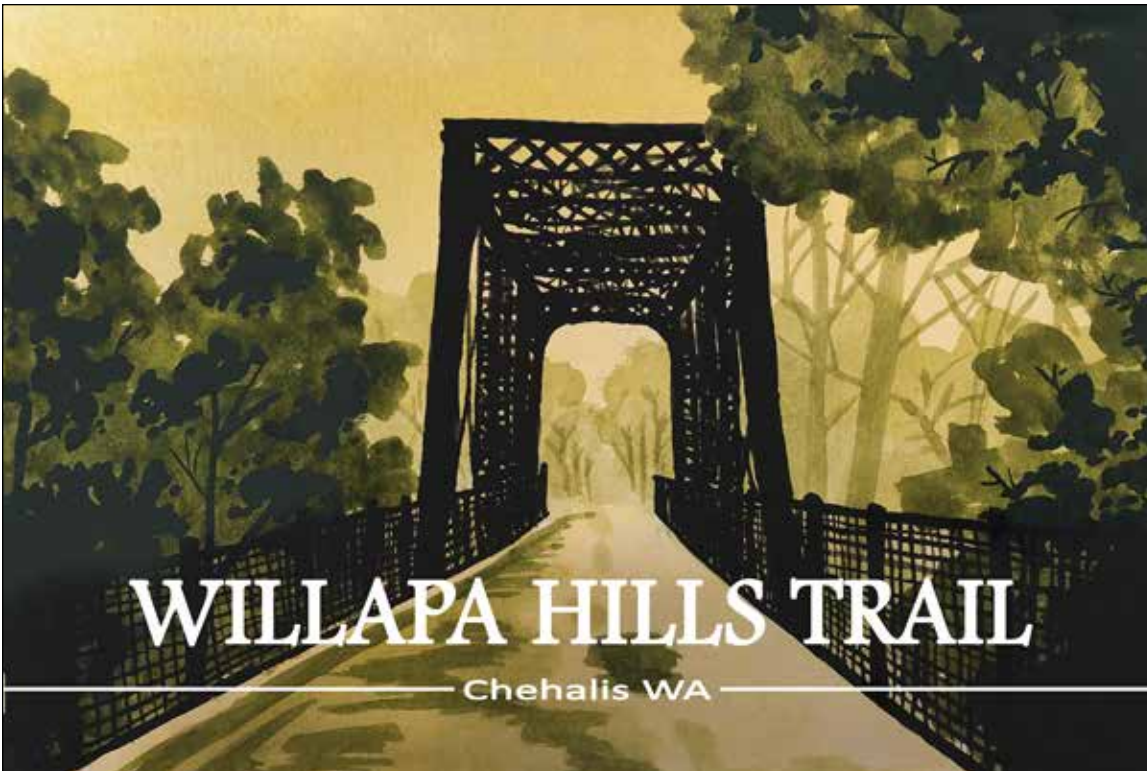

Located at the corner of Jackson Highway and Highway 508, this Jackson Highway landmark got its name from Burton's Dairy Farm; its barn is featured here.



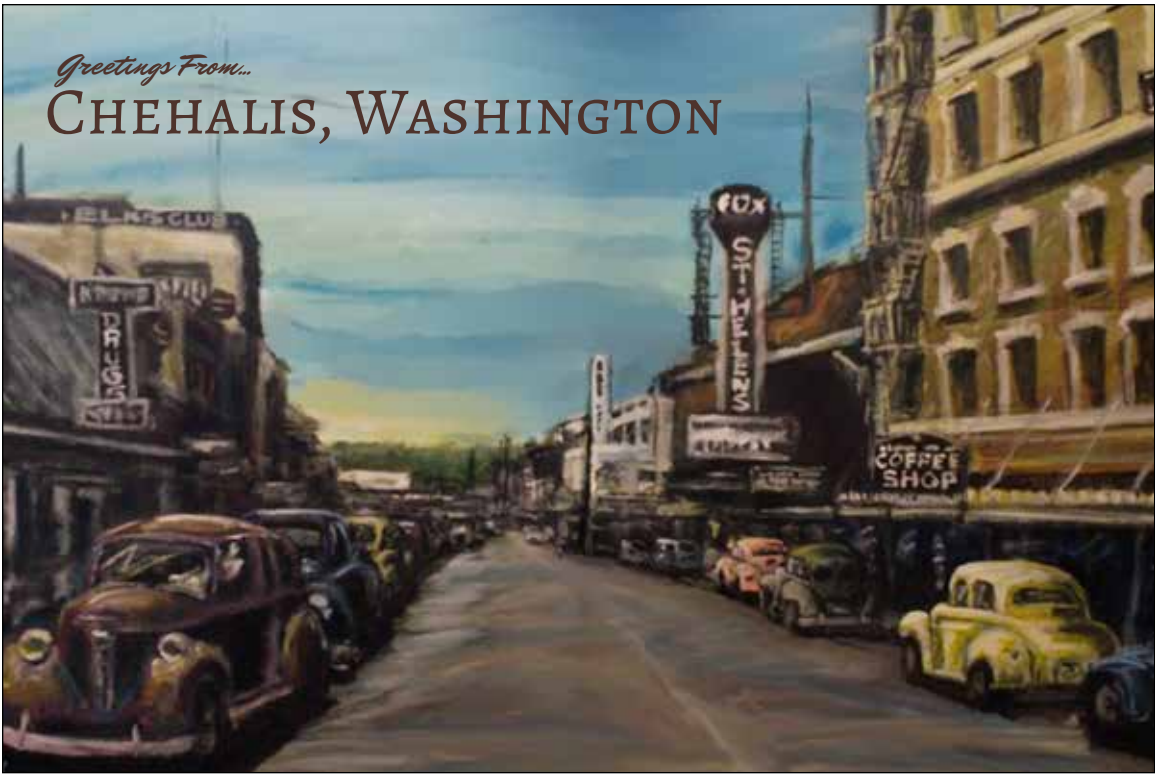
