Chip Duncan, Veterans Memorial Museum

- Veterans Journey Forward, Nation Org
- Hosting a resource fair with about eight vendors every other month
- New Service Officer is doing a great job making relationships.
- Plan to develop a disc golf team to support mental health
- The program is designed to be county-wide as the service officer also visits Lewis County.
- Funding for the service office is currently coming from Lewis County, and the rest comes from the Museum

Rollin Caryl, Lewis County Gospel Mission

- Roland served in law enforcement prior to becoming involved in supporting those experiencing homelessness.
- Roland joined the LC Gospel Mission on April 10.
- They are implementing changes and overcoming stereotypes that enable vs support. This includes establishing a drug free zone around the mission.
- Taking a look at additional facilities to offer offices for service providers.
- The local mission has its own Board and the organization is part of a larger organization called "City Gate." They have no official religious affiliation.

Joanne Schwartz, Chehalis-Centralia Railroad & Museum

- Are not currently operating due to their lack of insurance, but are working hard to remedy the issue.
- Waiting for FEMA funding to reimburse repair work that happened during last year's January flood. The projects have taken place and vendors have been paid but they are waiting for reimbursement to the organization.
- They hope to be partnering with Mt. Rainier Scenic Railroad. Mt. Rainier Scenic would run their trains on the CCRM track.
- They are planning to replace their current rental mobile office space to save money.

• A committee has been formed to monitor the continued work needed on the steam engine #15.
